WHAT CAN THIS BILL MEAN FOR OUR COMMUNITIES?

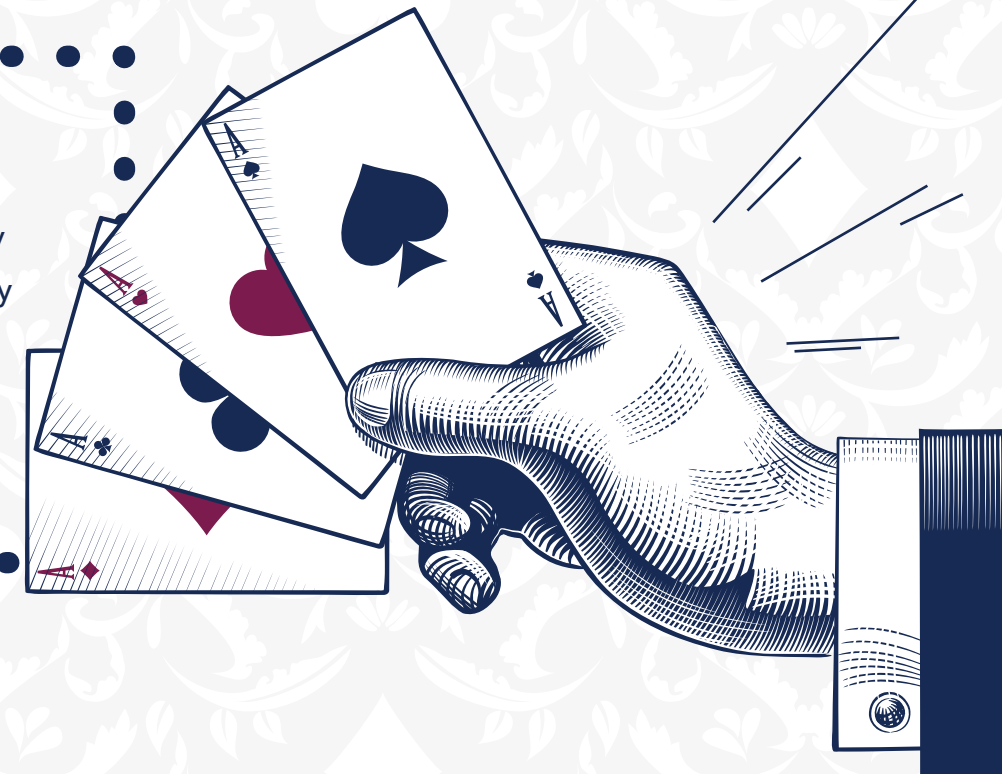
Beyond providing more engaging entertainment options for travelers in Indiana, VGTs offer both a means to support local businesses and create a source of state and local tax revenue. The passing of this legislation would drive value for all of Indiana's 92 counties.



WHAT'S A VIDEO GAME TERMINAL (VGT)?

VGTs are pay-to-play electronic video games that simulate common games that you may see in a casino like blackjack or poker. These highly-regulated games use a video display and award lucky patrons with free games or credits that may be redeemed for cash.

If legalized, VGTs can be installed in licensed Indiana bars, taverns, veterans' clubs, and truck stops.



Though VGTs would broaden gambling options, restrictions apply such as:

21+ VGTs only accessible to ages 21 and over

3-way 3-way liquor license required (breweries and wineries only have 2-way licenses for reference)

<\$ Minimum diesel sales required for truck stops



WHY WOULD I SUPPORT THE VIDEO GAME TERMINAL BILL?

- ☒ Local bars, taverns and veterans' clubs would benefit from a new revenue stream helping them stay in business and retain and add local jobs.
- ☒ VGTs offer an affordable entertainment option with a \$2 maximum bet and regulated 85-92% payback making it a responsible gambling experience.
- ☒ State and local communities in Indiana would receive a major windfall in tax revenue, with VGTs estimated to generate \$165 million in the first year and \$300 million by year four. This will give 80 counties access to tax revenue that had previously been exclusive to counties with casinos.
- ☒ VGT profits stay with local Indiana businesses instead of corporate HQs.
